We design and develop products in consideration of circular economy and energy efficiency principles. We increase our recycling activities and usage of recycled content in our products.



We communicate in a transparent way about our performance internally and externally, enabling the participation of employees in the roll-out of policies.



Awareness is raised by training and communication initiatives on all corporate levels. We encourage all employees to follow behavioral based safety rules.



We aim for no work related accidents amongst our employees, contractors and visitors, with special attention to avoiding accidents causing injuries.
